- 1. READ your notes!** Are they complete? Use the Notes Videos to fill in any blanks OR see me for help with what's missing. All of our notes are on CorbatScience.
- 2. WORDS TO KNOW** – the main terms for each unit are in your notes, in your textbook, and also usually posted on my website. These terms are guaranteed to be on the test.  
  
It's an excellent idea to make some type of vocabulary device that can be used to actively study for the test.
- 3. Practice Test Questions** – complete the mastery/practice test questions for EACH test. These are posted online under the heading "Helpful Pages".
- 4. The CK-12 Textbook** has some great resources linked to it that can be very helpful when studying.
- 5. HomeBase** -- keep up with your grades and possible missed assignments
- 6. email** – jcorbat@wcpss.net , email me with any questions or concerns, even the night before a test or quiz. Also check out the 'Contact Me' page on CorbatScience for more forms of communication.
